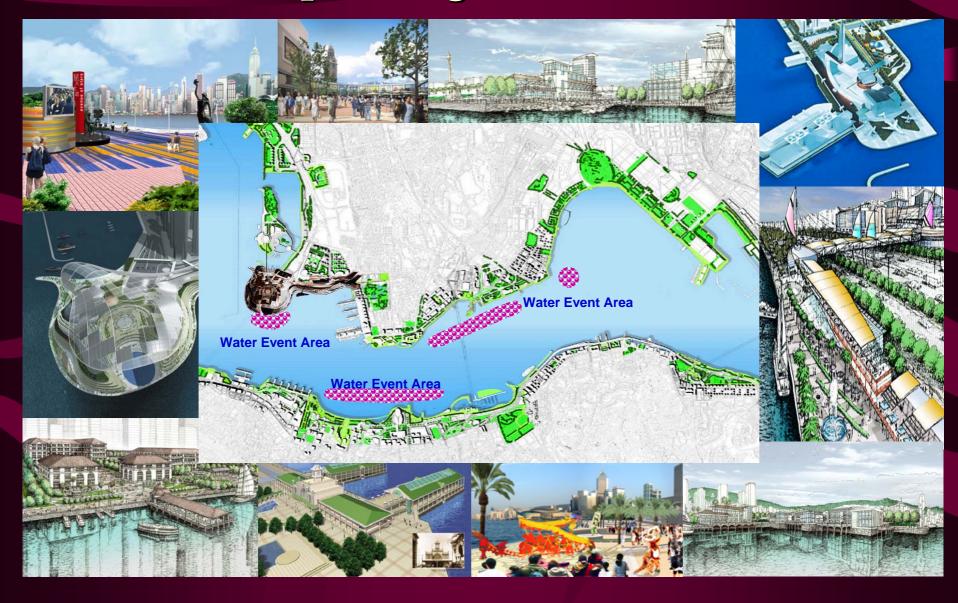

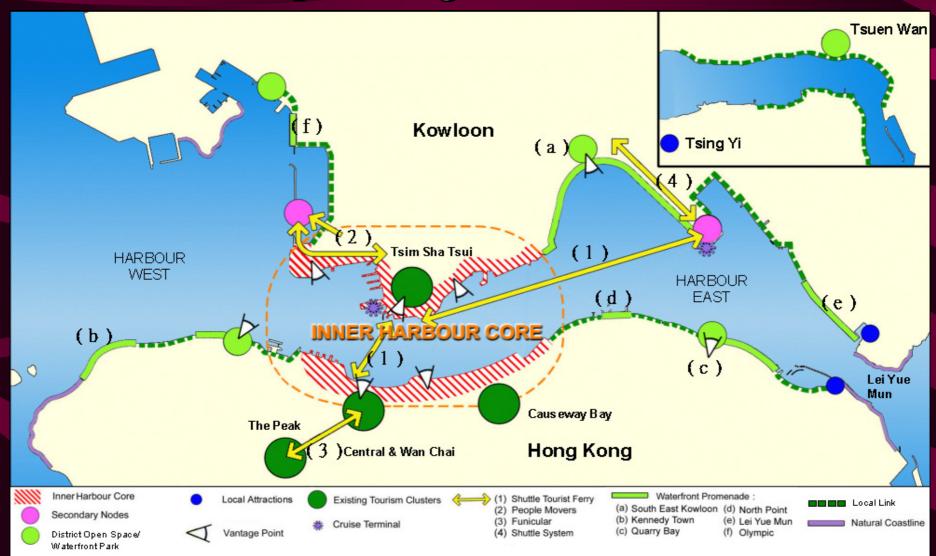

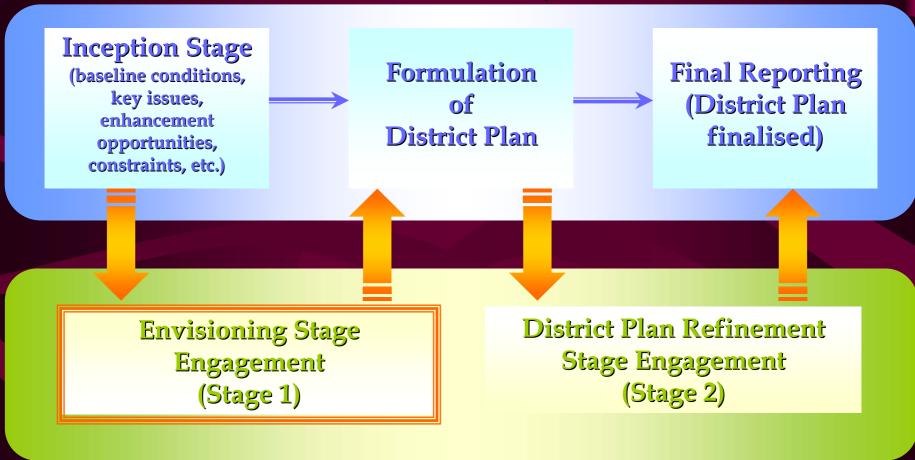

Envisioning Stage Engagement (Stage 1)

Questionnaire survey through street interview on favourable characteristics of Hung Hom, key issues and preferred roles of Hung Hom harbour-front

- Stage 1 engagement programme completed in February 2007



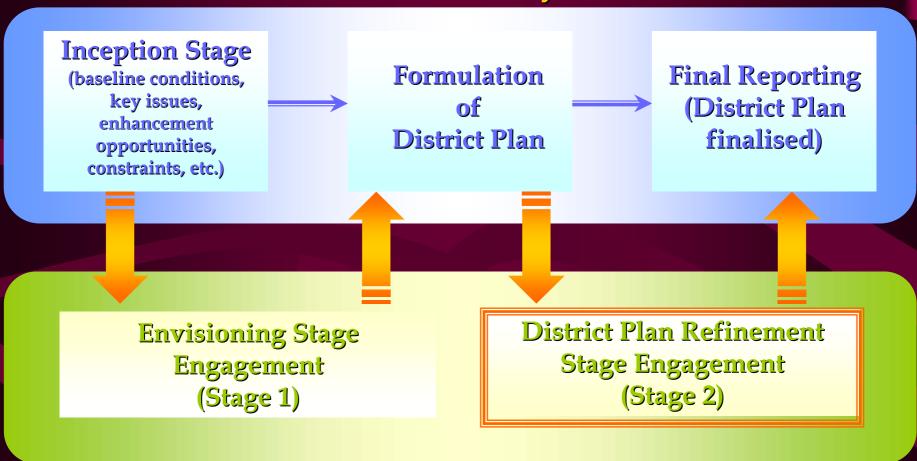
- Issues discussed and suggestions gathered:
 - connectivity (areas requiring improvement in pedestrian/vehicular connection; pedestrian connection to waterfront, access point, at grade pedestrian access, design & signage, etc.)
 - development density

 - land uses planning (KCRC Freight Yard, International Mail Centre, CDA site, etc.)
 - provision of harbourfront facilities
 - harbourfront enhancement suggestions

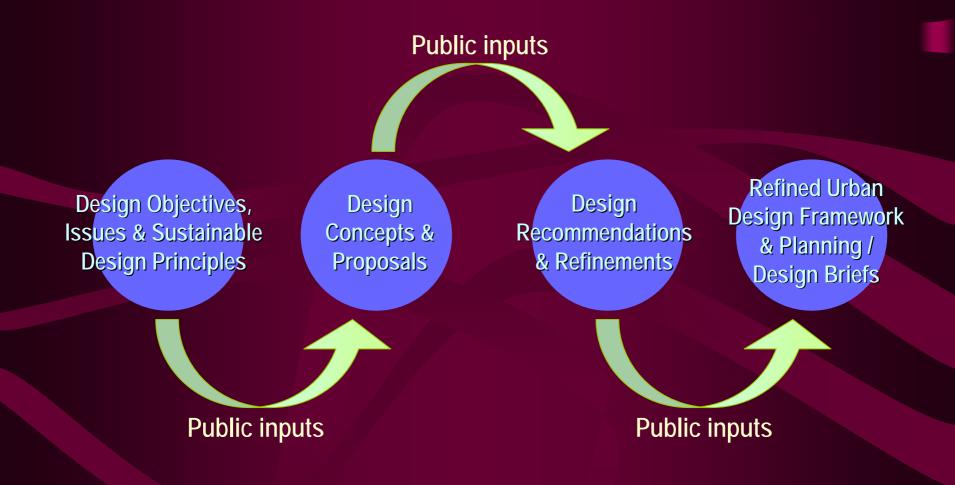

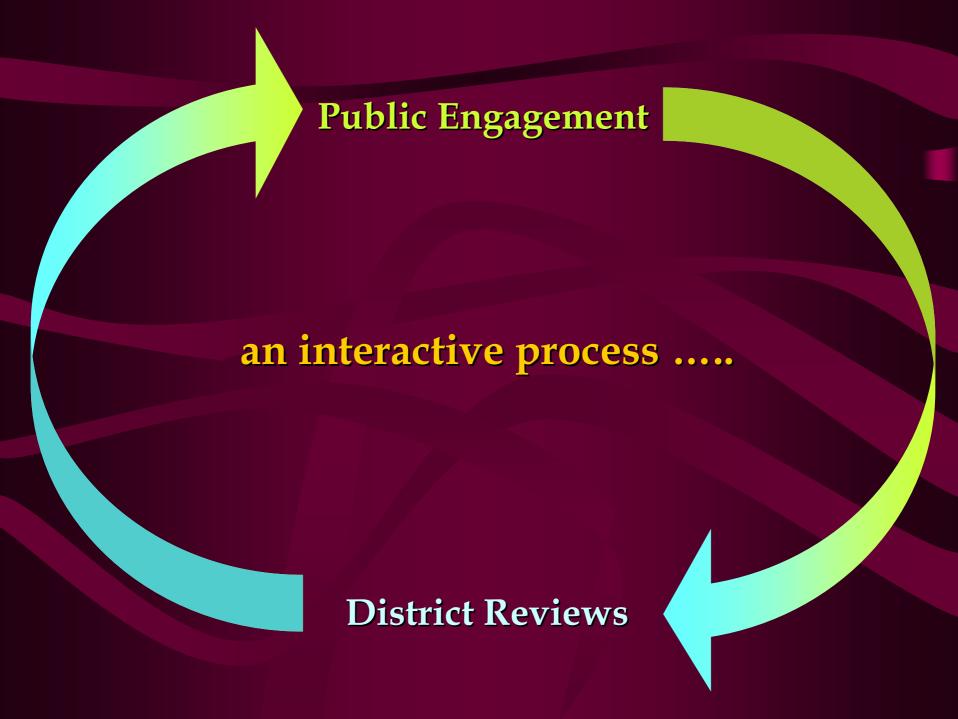
