## **Temporary Uses of the Kai Tak Site**

## 1. <u>General Management of the Kai Tak Site</u>

- 1.1 Since the de-commissioning of the ex-Kai Tak Airport, District Lands Office/Kowloon East ("DLO/KE"), Civil Engineering and Development Department ("CEDD") and Government Property Agency have been in management of the Kai Tak site, pending permanent land uses and developments.
- 1.2 The total area of the Kai Tak site is about 202 hectares. More than two-thirds of the site is currently let or allocated for various temporary uses. The existing temporary land uses of the Kai Tak site are described below.

#### 2. <u>Existing Temporary Land Uses</u>

2.1 Among the total area of 202 ha, 126.4 ha of which (63% of the total area) are currently let out on temporary basis or otherwise allocated temporarily to various government departments. For details, please refer to Table 1 at Annex.

## 2.2 Existing Short Term Lettings

2.2.1 There are currently 19 sites (total area: about 45.6 ha) in the Kai Tak area let by short term lettings to various private tenants by way of abbreviated tenders or direct grant for various purposes such as golf centre, non-profit making flying training school, fee-paying public carpark, open storage, bus parking etc. For details of these lettings, please refer to Appendix 3.

#### 2.3 Existing Temporary Government Land Allocations

2.3.1 There are currently 19 sites (total area: 80.8 ha) granted to various government departments by way of Temporary Government Land Allocations (TGLAs) for various purposes including works area, contractor's depot, storage, electricity sub-stations etc. Please refer to Appendix 4 for details of these allocations.

#### 2.3.2 Temporary Stockpiling of Excavated Materials by CEDD

- 2.3.2.1 Out of these 19 TGLAs, CEDD is granted with 6 allocations (i.e. G1 to G6 at Appendix 1) having a total area of about 73.1 ha for various purposes including work sites, works area, storage, contractor's depot, public filling barging points and stockpiling and storage area. Among these allocations, a total area of land amounting to 36.3 ha (G1 and G2 at Appendix 1) is currently occupied as works sites by CEDD for the purposes of the demolition of the ex-Kai Tai Terminal Building, carpark building and associated works.
- 2.3.2.2 While the public filling activities at the runway operation by the Fill Management Division (Civil Engineering Office) of CEDD has recently ceased, the Kowloon Development Office of CEDD has committed to take over the land concerned for stockpiling purposes for a term up to mid-2006. For the locations of the concerned plots of land, please refer to the plan at Appendix 2.
- 2.3.2.3 These stockpiling areas are required for the site formation contract for Choi Wan Development, currently managed by CEDD, which involves excavation of about 9 million m<sup>3</sup> of materials to form land for future housing and school development.
- 2.3.2.4 In order that the excavated materials from the site formation works can be put to beneficial use, it is planned that the materials will be delivered to other projects. To accommodate the possible programme differences between the Choi Wan contract and that of the receptor projects, temporary stockpiling of excavated materials at the runway of the former Kai Tak Airport, which is near the Choi Wan Development main site, has been allowed for under the contract.

- 2.3.2.5 CEDD has consulted both Kowloon City District Council and Kwun Tong District Council and obtained their in-principle agreement before implementation of the arrangement.
- 2.3.2.6 The current situation of stockpiles at Kai Tak is caused by the latest developments of the receptor projects. CEDD is aware of the conditions, and are putting together a number of improvement measures. The results should be visible in a few months. As immediate measures to reduce possible environmental and visual impacts, the stockpiled materials are hydroseeded as soon as possible, and proper temporary drainage system has been provided to prevent silty discharge into the harbour.

#### 3. <u>Proposed Temporary Land Uses</u>

3.1 About 12.9 ha land (6% of the total area) are proposed to be let by way of short term tenancies to private tenants or temporarily allocated to various government departments for various purposes including storage, landscape gardening, sports centre, etc., all of which are under active processing. It is the intention that all the proposed short-term tenancies will be subject to public tendering. For details, please refer to Table 2 at the Annex.

#### 4. <u>The Remaining Vacant Land</u>

- 4.1 To ensure better utilisation of the vacant land, DLO/KE has from time to time invited relevant government departments to submit applications for temporary use of the vacant land in Kai Tak. Some applications for temporary land allocations for works area or storage purposes have been received and have been processed/are being processed by DLO/KE.
- 4.2 There are currently 11 scattered plots of vacant land with a total area of about 62.3 ha (31% of total area). Table 3 at Annex refers.
- 4.3 Temporary active uses of these plots of vacant land, however, are highly constrained due to the following reasons:

#### 4.3.1 (a) Traffic and Environmental Constraints:

4.3.1.1 Most of these vacant sites are having accessibility problems as either

because they are located far away from public roads or they are facing traffic capacity problems as advised by the Transport Department, the existing road networks surrounding the former Kai Tak Airport such as Kai Fuk Road and Prince Edward Road East are not designed for any large scale conversion of uses of the airport which may generate a heavy flow of traffic. Given the possible adverse traffic impacts that may have to the existing road system, the Transport Department does not support any active temporary uses that may generate a heavy traffic flow. Besides, due to the close proximity of some of these vacant sites to the residential developments such as Sky Tower and Richland Gardens, Environmental Protection Department does not support active uses or sports activities which would likely to have noise and/or lighting impact to nearby residents. In view of these constraints, viable temporary uses of these plots of land are to certain extent limited.

#### 4.3.2 **(b) Current Site Conditions:**

4.3.2.1 Land decontamination works had been carried out by CEDD at the North Apron area of the Kai Tak site. Six sites (i.e. V4 to V9 at Appendix 1) with a total area of about 45.9 ha are now unleveled grounds filled with earth and rubbles after decontamination works. The current site conditions are therefore considered not suitable for beneficial uses.

#### 4.4 **One-off Public / Non-profit Making Events:**

- 4.4.1 Notwithstanding the traffic and environmental constraints, two plots of land (as donated V10 and V11 on the plan at Appendix 1) have been actively used for temporary occupations by applicants such as Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps for aero-modelling and various charitable organizations such as Christian Action and Sowers Action for various one-off non-profit making/public events such as fair/variety show, mass games, walkathon etc. and for commercial film-shooting.
- 4.4.2 According to DLO/KE's records, for members' reference, the sites were occupied for the above said events for over 100 days in the past 12 months.

#### 5. <u>Conclusion</u>

Pending finalization of permanent land uses, departments have been exploring viable temporary uses of the Kai Tak site. To sum up, about 139.3 ha land (i.e. 69% of the total area) is currently let / proposed to be let to various private tenants or allocated to various government departments for a wide range of short term uses. Whilst temporary uses of the remaining 62.3 ha vacant land are highly constrained due to the current site conditions and traffic and environmental problems, departments will, however, continue to identity appropriate temporary uses as far as possible to ensure optimum utilization of the land.






